The Mission: Turn heads and blow minds with the most authentic, passionate presentation of the timeless music of Queensrÿche that the West Coast has ever seen. Anarchy-X is a tribute to the creative output of Queensrÿche's classic, original lineup, and the band plays songs from all recordings from the 1983 self-titled EP through 1994's "Promised Land" release.

ABOUT THE BAND:

Scott Nelson - Drums, Electronic Percussion, Backing Vocals

With over 30 years behind the kit, powerhouse drummer Scott Nelson drives the pulse of Anarchy-X with authority and precision. Influences include Neil Peart, John Bonham, Scott Travis, Mike Portnoy, and Jeff Porcaro. A multi-instrumental musician and engineer, Scott is also responsible for the sound design of the band and the backing sound effects that are crucial to an authentic performance of Queensrÿche's intricate music.

Ben Triman - Electric and Acoustic Guitars, Backing Vocals

Orange County native Ben Triman has been playing guitar since age 15, and professionally for over 20 years. Early influences included Clapton, Page, Hendrix, Gilmour, Van Halen, Satriani, SRV, and BB King. From intimate coffee houses to arena tours in front of thousands, his resume is robust. For Anarchy-X, Ben performs the musical role of founding Queensrÿche guitarist Chris DeGarmo.

Paul Carlos - Electric and Acoustic Guitars, Backing Vocals

As his father was a musician on the Del-Fi label, Paul grew up surrounded by music of all genres. As a guitarist, Paul cut his teeth on the Hollywood club circuit, in a variety of bands and venues over the years. He studied with Shrapnel recording artist and GIT faculty member Darren Householder, and attended a semester at the George Lynch Guitar Dojo. Three decades of musical experience have taught him the importance of attention to detail, making Paul the perfect fit to replicate Michael Wilton's sophisticated guitar parts.

Brad Schechter - Lead Vocals

Born in Inglewood, CA, Brad began studying classical piano at age 6 at South Bay Conservatory in Palos Verdes, and continued to study there well into his adult years. He earned a B.A. in Theatre from Loyola Marymount University in 2001, and has been singing, playing in bands, and recording original music his whole life. Rare is the vocalist who is up to the challenge of stepping into Geoff Tate's shoes, but Brad delivers show after show.

Kurt Sheaffer - Bass Guitar, Backing Vocals

Kurt has been playing bass in original, cover, and tribute bands across Southern California for decades, with an emphasis on rock, metal, and country. His unshakeable groove and fierce rocker stage presence in the role of bassist Eddie Jackson are impossible to ignore.
